- Averages for college acceptance are based on core subjects, not open level
- English; law; science; technology
- Science programs usually require 1 math & 2 sciences
- Prerequisites specified by each college program
- College programs are available for students in college and workplace level (Fleming; St. Lawrence)

University Bound



- 6 4U/M level courses
- Marks... First set of marks to universities are Grade 11
- Average of your top 6 grade 12 U or M levels plus specified minimums
- Science programs – 75+% minimum
- Other programs – 70+% minimum
- Health Sciences – biology and chemistry, but take all three
- Prerequisites specified by each university
